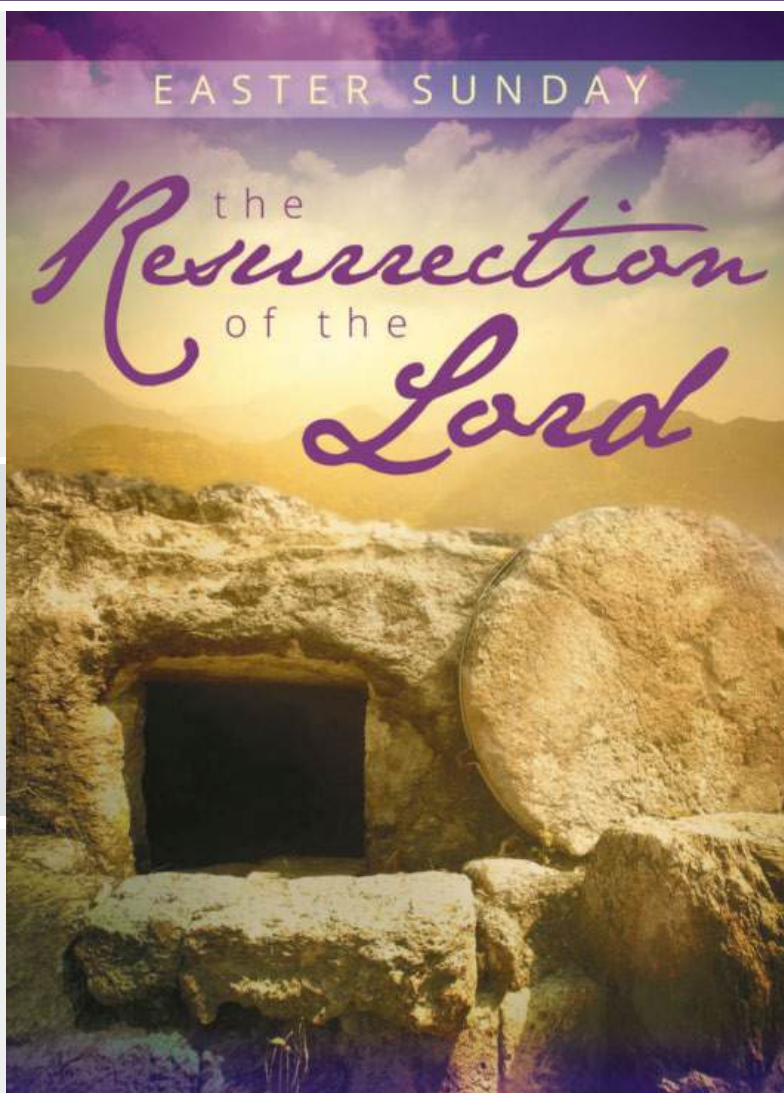

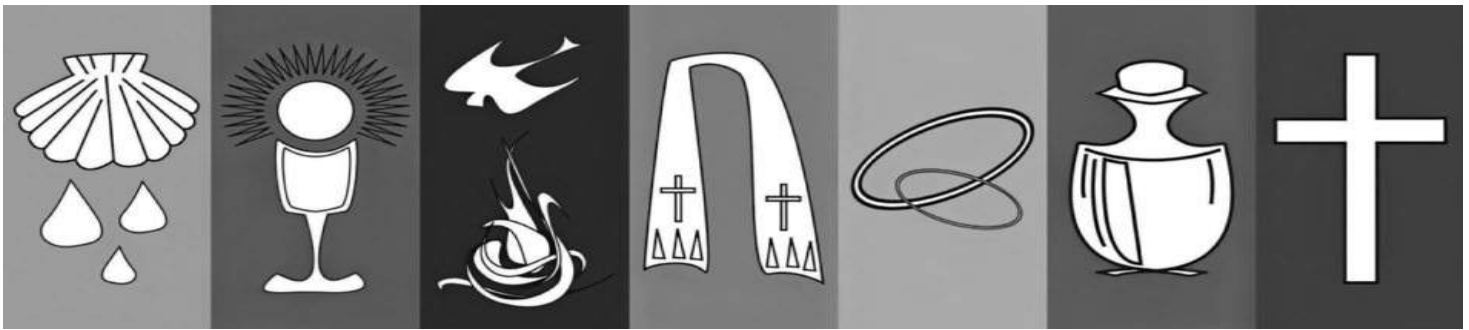

The Heart of Our Faith: Christ Is Risen!

“If Christ has not been raised, then empty is our preaching; empty, too, your faith.” – 1 Corinthians 15:14.

Easter is the most important celebration of our Christian faith. It is the joyful proclamation that Jesus Christ, who suffered and died for us, has risen from the dead! His Resurrection is the very heart of our faith, the foundation on which everything else stands. Without it, our faith would have no meaning.

Easter marks the end of the 40-day Lenten journey of prayer, fasting, and penance. It celebrates Jesus’ victory over death, sin, suffering, and evil. The Catechism of the Catholic Church (638–648) beautifully teaches that the Resurrection is the crowning truth of our faith, preached and lived by the first Christians, and still the center of our life today.

Through Baptism, we are united to the Risen Christ. In every Eucharist, we are nourished by His Body and transformed by His Spirit. The Holy Spirit, who raised Jesus from the dead, is at work in each of us, giving us new life, peace, and joy. The Cross, once a sign of suffering, now shines with glory and hope through the Resurrection.

May the Risen Lord bless you and your loved ones with His peace, His joy, and His everlasting love. May this Easter bring new life and renewal to your heart.

Happy Easter! Christ is truly Risen! Alleluia!



El Corazón de Nuestra Fe: Cristo ha Resucitado

«Si Cristo no ha resucitado, vacía es nuestra predicación; vacía, también, nuestra fe». - 1 Corintios 15:14.

Carta Del Sacerdote

La Pascua es la celebración más importante de nuestra fe cristiana. Es la proclamación gozosa de que Jesucristo, que sufrió y murió por nosotros, ha resucitado de entre los muertos. Su Resurrección es el corazón mismo de nuestra fe, el fundamento sobre el que se asienta todo lo demás. Sin ella, nuestra fe no tendría sentido.

La Pascua marca el final de los 40 días de Cuaresma de oración, ayuno y penitencia. Celebra la victoria de Jesús sobre la muerte, el pecado, el sufrimiento y el mal. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica (638-648) enseña bellamente que la Resurrección es la verdad suprema de nuestra fe, predicada y vivida por los primeros cristianos, y todavía hoy el centro de nuestra vida.

Por el Bautismo, estamos unidos a Cristo resucitado. En cada Eucaristía, somos alimentados por su Cuerpo y transformados por su Espíritu. El Espíritu Santo, que resucitó a Jesús de entre los muertos, actúa en cada uno de nosotros, dándonos nueva vida, paz y alegría. La Cruz, antes signo de sufrimiento, resplandece ahora de gloria y esperanza por la Resurrección.

Que el Señor resucitado te bendiga a ti y a tus seres queridos con su paz, su alegría y su amor eterno. Que esta Pascua traiga nueva vida y renovación a tu corazón.

¡Feliz Pascua! Cristo ha resucitado. ¡Aleluya!

On May 5, 2000, Pope Saint John Paul II decreed that the Second Sunday of Easter, the Octave of Easter, would be known as Divine Mercy Sunday. The feast was established by the pope after he canonized Saint Faustina, a humble Polish nun to whom Jesus revealed his message of divine mercy.

Born in 1905, Saint Faustina became a member of the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy at age 20. While at the convent, beginning in February 1931, she received several revelations from Jesus, who communicated to her the depth of his mercy and his desire that all be merciful to one another.

The Lord also shared with her his desire that a feast day be dedicated to Divine Mercy and that it be celebrated on the Sunday after Easter. Saint Faustina's diary, in which she details the revelations, includes 14 occasions on which the Lord asks that a feast day be established. One of those can be found in diary entry 699:

I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day, the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day, all the divine floodgates through which grace flow are opened... It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy.

El 5 de Mayo de 2000, El Papa Juan Pablo II decretó que el Segundo Domingo de Pascua, la Octava de Pascua, se conocería como el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. Esta festividad fue establecida por el Papa tras la canonización de Santa Faustina, una humilde monja polaca a quien Jesús reveló su mensaje de divina misericordia.

Nacida en 1905, Santa Faustina se convirtió en miembro de la Congregación de las Hermanas de Nuestra Señora de la Misericordia a los 20 años. Mientras estaba en el convento, a partir de febrero de 1931, recibió varias revelaciones de Jesús, quien le comunicó la profundidad de su misericordia y su deseo de que todos sean misericordiosos unos con otros.

El Señor también le comunicó su deseo de que se dedicara una festividad a la Divina Misericordia y se celebrara el domingo después de Pascua. El diario de santa Faustina, en el que detalla las revelaciones, incluye catorce ocasiones en las que el Señor pide que se establezca una festividad. Una de ellas se encuentra en la entrada 699 del diario:

Deseo que la Fiesta de la Misericordia sea refugio y amparo para todas las almas, especialmente para los pobres pecadores. Ese día, se abren las entrañas de mi tierna misericordia. Derramo un océano de gracias sobre las almas que se acercan a la Fuente de mi misericordia. Quien se confiese y reciba la Sagrada Comunión obtendrá el perdón completo de los pecados y del castigo. Ese día, se abren todas las compuertas divinas por donde fluye la gracia... Es mi deseo que se celebre solemnemente el primer domingo después de Pascua. La humanidad no tendrá paz hasta que se vuelva a la Fuente de mi Misericordia.

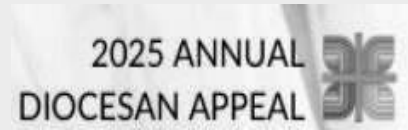

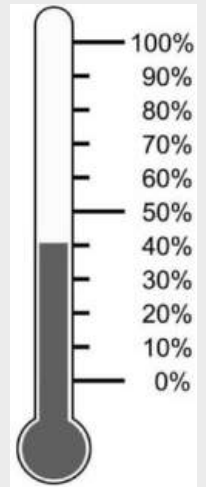

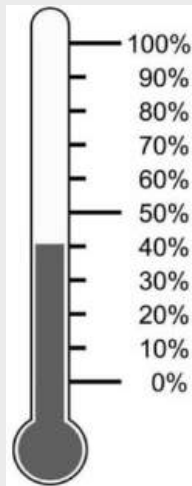
