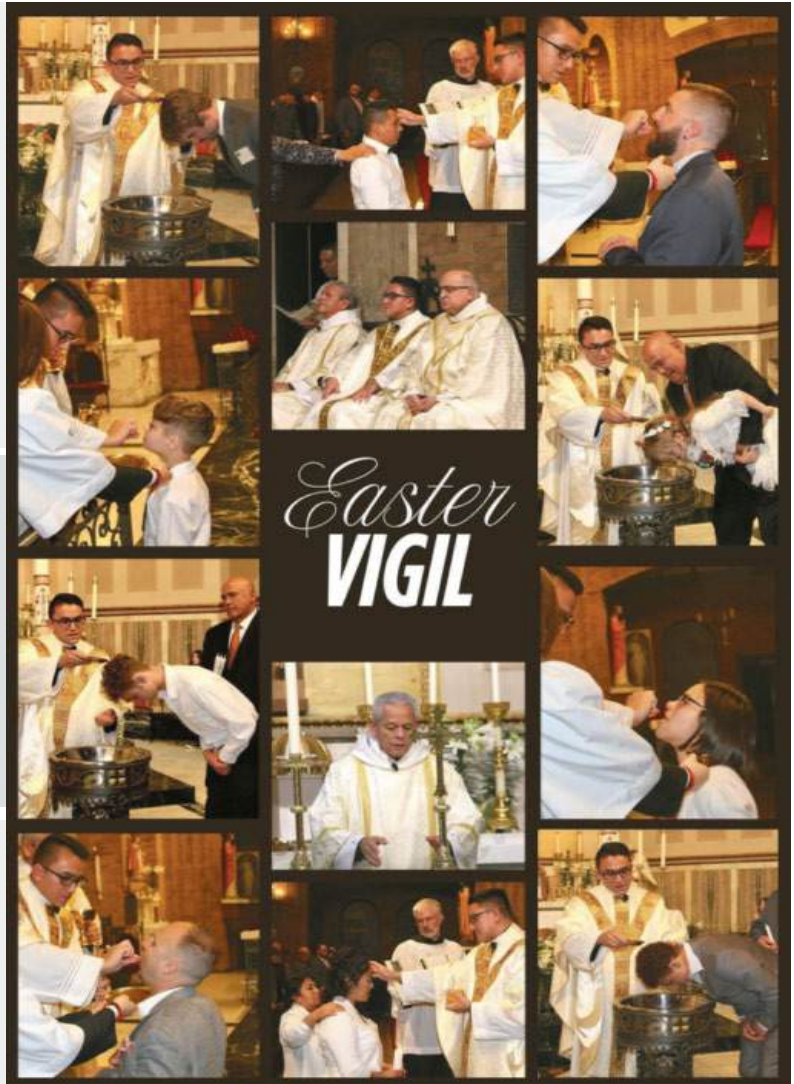

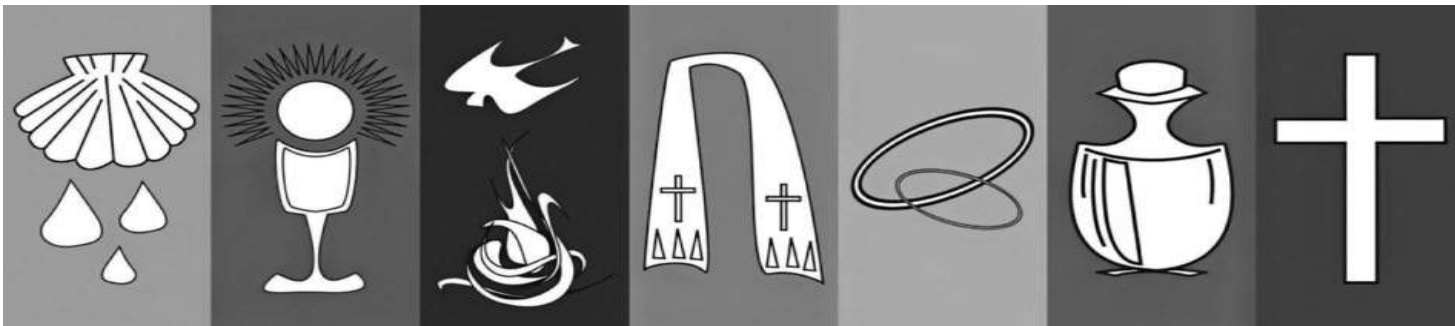

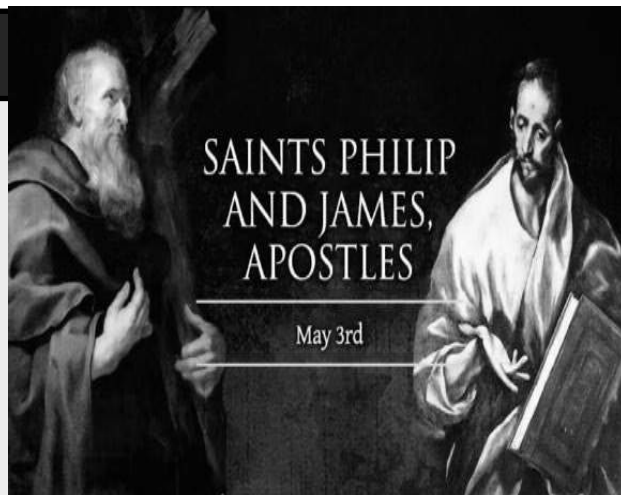

Saints Philip and James' Story

James, Son of Alphaeus: We know nothing of this man except his name, and, of course, the fact that Jesus chose him to be one of the 12 pillars of the New Israel, his Church. He is not the James of Acts, son of Clopas, "brother" of Jesus and later bishop of Jerusalem and the traditional author of the Letter of James. James, son of Alphaeus, is also known as James the Lesser to avoid confusing him with James the son of Zebedee, also an apostle and known as James the Greater.

Philip: Philip came from the same town as Peter and Andrew, Bethsaida in Galilee. Jesus called him directly, whereupon he sought out Nathanael and told him of the "one about whom Moses wrote" (Jn 1:45).

Like the other apostles, Philip took a long time coming to realize who Jesus was. On one occasion, when Jesus saw the great multitude following him and wanted to give them food, he asked Philip where they should buy bread for the people to eat. Saint John comments, "[Jesus] said this to test him, because he himself knew what he was going to do" (Jn 6:6). Philip answered, "Two hundred days' wages worth of food would not be enough for each of them to have a little [bit]" (Jn 6:7).

John's story is not a put-down of Philip. It was simply necessary for these men who were to be the foundation stones of the Church to see the clear distinction between humanity's total helplessness apart from God and the human ability to be a bearer of divine power by God's gift.

On another occasion, we can almost hear the exasperation in Jesus's voice. After Thomas had complained that they did not know where Jesus was going, Jesus said, "I am the way. If you know me, then you will also know my Father. From now on you do know him and have seen him" (Jn 14:6a, 7). Then Philip said, "Master, show us the Father, and that will be enough for us" (Jn 14:8). Enough! Jesus answered, "Have I been with you for so long a time and you still do not know me, Philip? Whoever has seen me has seen the Father" (Jn 14:9a).

Possibly because Philip bore a Greek name or because he was thought to be close to Jesus, some gentile proselytes came to him and asked him to introduce them to Jesus. Philip went to Andrew, and Andrew went to Jesus. Jesus's reply in John's Gospel is indirect; Jesus says that now his "hour" has come, that in a short time he will give his life for Jew and gentile alike.

La historia de los santos Felipe y Santiago

Santiago, hijo de Alfeo: No sabemos nada de este hombre, salvo su nombre y, por supuesto, que Jesús lo eligió como uno de los doce pilares del Nuevo Israel, su Iglesia. No es el Santiago de los Hechos, hijo de Cleofás, «hermano» de Jesús y posteriormente obispo de Jerusalén, y el autor tradicional de la Carta de Santiago. Santiago, hijo de Alfeo, también es conocido como Santiago el Menor para evitar confundirlo con Santiago, hijo de Zebedeo, también apóstol, conocido como Santiago el Mayor.

Felipe : Felipe era de Betsaida, Galilea, el mismo pueblo que Pedro y Andrés. Jesús lo llamó directamente, y él buscó a Natanael y le habló de aquel de quien escribió Moisés (Jn 1,45).

Al igual que los demás apóstoles, Felipe tardó mucho en comprender quién era Jesús. En una ocasión, al ver que la gran multitud lo seguía y quería darles de comer, le preguntó a Felipe dónde comprarían pan para que la gente comiera. San Juan comenta: «[Jesús] dijo esto para ponerlo a prueba, porque él mismo sabía lo que iba a hacer» (Jn 6,6). Felipe respondió: «Doscientos denarios de pan no bastarían para que cada uno comiera un poco» (Jn 6,7).

La historia de Juan no es una crítica a Felipe. Simplemente era necesario que estos hombres, que serían las piedras angulares de la Iglesia, vieran la clara distinción entre la total indefensión de la humanidad separada de Dios y la capacidad humana de ser portadora del poder divino por el don de Dios.

En otra ocasión, casi podemos percibir la exasperación en la voz de Jesús. Después de que Tomás se quejara de no saber adónde iba Jesús, Jesús dijo: «Yo soy el camino. Si me conocen a mí, también conocerán a mi Padre. Desde ahora lo conocen y lo han visto» (Jn 14:6a, 7). Entonces Felipe dijo: «Maestro, muéstranos al Padre, y nos basta» (Jn 14:8). ¡Basta! Jesús respondió: «¿Tanto tiempo hace que estoy con ustedes y todavía no me conocen, Felipe? El que me ha visto a mí, ha visto al Padre» (Jn 14:9a).

Posiblemente porque Felipe tenía un nombre griego o porque se creía que era cercano a Jesús, algunos prosélitos gentiles acudieron a él y le pidieron que los presentara a Jesús. Felipe fue a Andrés, y Andrés fue a Jesús. La respuesta de Jesús en el Evangelio de Juan es indirecta: Jesús dice que ahora ha llegado su hora, que dentro de poco dará su vida por judíos y gentiles por igual.

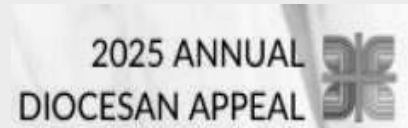

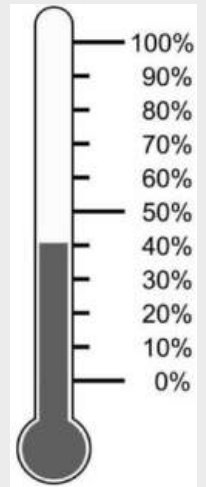

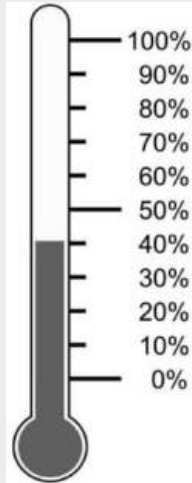
