

From The Priest



Dear friends:

This past week we mourned the death of Pope Francis. We remember his compassion, mercy, and foremost a humble pastor. The election of a new pope begins this Wednesday May 7th.

There have been an endless number of Popes throughout Rome's history, 266 to be exact. Some reigned for long, some only for a short time, but how were these Popes chosen? I would like to share with you answers to some frequent questions surrounding the papal election.

What happens between the pope's death and the beginning of the conclave (papal election)? The cardinals hold a series of meetings at the Vatican called general congregations. They discuss the needs and the challenges facing the Catholic Church globally.

How many cardinals are there in the Church? There are 252 cardinals, but only 135 of them are eligible to vote in a papal conclave. These 135 are under the age of 80. The remaining cardinals, over 80, are still considered members of the College of Cardinals but are ineligible to vote. The country with the most cardinals who can vote is Italy with 17; the United States has 17 cardinals but only 10 can vote.

Are the cardinals allowed to discuss with reporters the workings of the conclave? Throughout the election process, the Cardinal electors must refrain from sending letters or engaging in conversations, including phone calls, except in cases of extreme urgency.

In addition, they are not allowed to receive newspapers or magazines of any nature, or follow radio or television broadcasts.

How do the cardinals cast their vote? The cardinals vote by written secret ballot, processing one by one up to Michelangelo's fresco of the Last Judgment, saying a prayer and dropping the twice-folded ballot in a large chalice.

How often do the cardinals vote each day? Four rounds of balloting are taken every day; two in the morning and two in the afternoon, until a candidate receives two-thirds of the vote.

How many votes are needed to be elected? One needs two-thirds of the vote (90) to be elected.

How are the ballots tabulated? The results of each ballot are counted aloud and recorded by three cardinals designated as recorders.

What happens after a pope is elected? Once a cardinal receives enough votes and accepts the role, white smoke will rise from the Vatican chimney, signaling to the world that a new pope has been elected. The newly elected pope then chooses a papal name and puts on white vestments. Following this, he is introduced from the balcony of St Peter's Basilica by the words "*Habemus Papam!*" — *Latin for "We have a Pope!"*. The new pope processes out onto the balcony and imparts his blessing to the faithful gathered in St Peter's Square and to the entire world.

Let us pray that the Holy Spirit guide the conclave of cardinals to elect a Holy Father who is humble and has the heart of a pastor.

Carta Del Sacerdote

Queridos amigos:

La semana pasada lloramos la muerte del Papa Francisco. Recordamos su compasión, su misericordia y, sobre todo, su humildad como pastor. La elección de un nuevo Papa comienza este miércoles 7 de mayo.

Ha habido un sinfín de Papas a lo largo de la historia de Roma, 266 para ser exactos.

Algunos reinaron durante mucho tiempo, otros sólo por poco tiempo, pero ¿cómo fueron elegidos estos Papas? Me gustaría compartir con usted las respuestas a algunas preguntas frecuentes en torno a la elección papal.

¿Qué sucede entre la muerte del Papa y el comienzo del cónclave (elección papal)?

Los cardenales tienen una serie de reuniones en el Vaticano llamadas congregaciones generales. En ellas discuten las necesidades y los retos a los que se enfrenta la Iglesia Católica en todo el mundo.

¿Cuántos cardenales hay en la Iglesia?

Hay 252 cardenales, pero sólo 135 de ellos son elegibles para votar en un cónclave papal. Estos 135 tienen menos de 80 años. Los cardenales restantes, mayores de 80 años, siguen siendo considerados miembros del Colegio Cardenalicio, pero no son elegibles para votar. El país con más cardenales que pueden votar es Italia, con 17; Estados Unidos tiene 17 cardenales, pero sólo 10 pueden votar.

¿Pueden los cardenales hablar con los periodistas sobre el funcionamiento del cónclave?

Durante todo el proceso de elección, los cardenales electores deben evitar enviar cartas o entablar conversaciones, incluidas las llamadas telefónicas, a no ser que se trate de casos de extrema urgencia.

Además, no pueden recibir periódicos ni revistas de ninguna naturaleza, ni seguir las emisiones de radio o televisión.

¿Cómo votan los cardenales? Los cardenales votan mediante voto secreto escrito, dirigiéndose uno a uno al fresco del Juicio Final de Miguel Ángel, rezando una oración y depositando la boleta doblada dos veces en un gran cáliz.

¿Cuántas veces al día votan los cardenales?

Cada día se celebran cuatro votaciones: dos por la mañana y dos por la tarde, hasta que un candidato obtiene dos tercios de los votos.

¿Cuántos votos se necesitan para ser elegido?

Se necesitan dos tercios de los votos (90) para ser elegido.

¿Cómo se tabulan las boletas? Los resultados de cada votación son contados en voz alta y registrados por tres cardenales designados como registradores.

¿Qué sucede después de la elección del Papa?

Una vez que un cardenal recibe suficientes votos y acepta el cargo, sale humo blanco de la chimenea del Vaticano, señalando al mundo que se ha elegido un nuevo Papa. A continuación, el Papa electo elige un nombre papal y se viste con las vestiduras blancas. A continuación, es presentado desde el balcón de la Basílica de San Pedro con las palabras «¡Habemus Papam!». -- que en latín significa «¡Tenemos un Papa!». El nuevo Papa sale al balcón e imparte su bendición a los fieles reunidos en la Plaza de San Pedro y al mundo entero.

Recemos para que el Espíritu Santo guíe al cónclave cardenalicio en la elección de un Santo Padre humilde y con corazón de pastor.



OF ÁVILA

(1499-1569)
Feast: May 10



Saint John of Avila's Story

Born in the Castile region of Spain, John was sent at the age of 14 to the University of Salamanca to study law. He later moved to Alcalá, where he studied philosophy and theology before his ordination as a diocesan priest.

After John's parents died and left him as their sole heir to a considerable fortune, he distributed his money to the poor. In 1527, he traveled to Seville, hoping to become a missionary in Mexico. The archbishop of that city persuaded him to stay and spread the faith in Andalusia. During nine years of work there, he developed a reputation as an engaging preacher, a perceptive spiritual director, and a wise confessor.

Because John was not afraid to denounce vice in high places, he was investigated by the Inquisition but was cleared in 1533. He later worked in Cordoba and then in Granada, where he organized the University of Baeza, the first of several colleges run by diocesan priests who dedicated themselves to teaching and giving spiritual direction to young people.

He was friends with Saints Francis Borgia, Ignatius of Loyola, John of God, John of the Cross, Peter of Alcantara, and Teresa of Avila. John of Avila worked closely with members of the Society of Jesus and helped their growth within Spain and its colonies. John's mystical writings have been translated into several languages.

He was beatified in 1894, canonized in 1970, and declared a doctor of the Church on October 7, 2012. St. John of Avila's liturgical feast is celebrated on May 10.

La historia de San Juan de Ávila

Nacido en Castilla, España, Juan ingresó a la Universidad de Salamanca a los 14 años para estudiar Derecho. Posteriormente se trasladó a Alcalá, donde estudió Filosofía y Teología antes de su ordenación sacerdotal diocesana.

Tras la muerte de sus padres, dejándolo como único heredero de una considerable fortuna, Juan distribuyó su dinero entre los pobres. En 1527, viajó a Sevilla con la esperanza de convertirse en misionero en México. El arzobispo de esa ciudad lo convenció de quedarse y difundir la fe en Andalucía. Durante nueve años de trabajo allí, se forjó una reputación como predicador cautivador, director espiritual perspicaz y sabio confesor.

Como Juan no temía denunciar los vicios en las altas esferas, fue investigado por la Inquisición, pero fue absuelto en 1533. Trabajó más tarde en Córdoba y luego en Granada, donde organizó la Universidad de Baeza, la primera de varias universidades dirigidas por sacerdotes diocesanos que se dedicaron a enseñar y dar dirección espiritual a los jóvenes.

Fue amigo de los santos Francisco de Borja, Ignacio de Loyola, Juan de Dios, Juan de la Cruz, Pedro de Alcántara y Teresa de Ávila. Juan de Ávila colaboró estrechamente con miembros de la Compañía de Jesús y contribuyó a su crecimiento en España y sus colonias. Sus escritos místicos se han traducido a varios idiomas.

Fue beatificado en 1894, canonizado en 1970 y declarado doctor de la Iglesia el 7 de octubre de 2012. La fiesta litúrgica de San Juan de Ávila se celebra el 10 de mayo.






