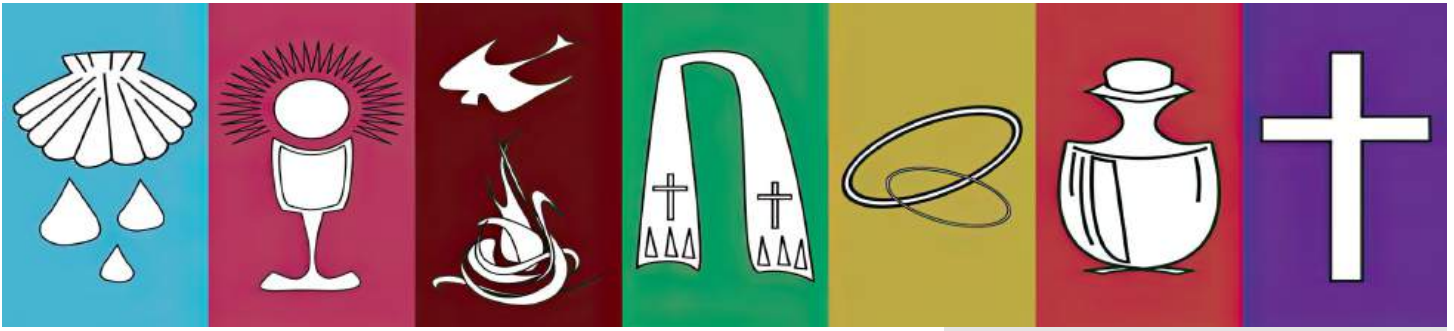

Dear Friends, as we celebrate the Sixth Sunday of Easter, in our first reading, the Church invites us to turn our eyes to a remarkable scene from the Acts of the Apostles (Acts 8:5-8, 14-17) one that speaks not only to the early Christians, but to each one of us gathered here today.

Philip, one of the first deacons of the Church, goes down into Samaria a place the Jewish world of his time largely overlooked and even despised. He does not wait for people to come to him. He goes. He brings the Good News to those on the margins, to those the world had written off. And what happens? Everything changes. The crowds listen. The sick are healed. Those bound by darkness are set free. And then comes the most beautiful detail of all "There was great joy in that city (Acts 8:8)"

What brought that joy? It was not a program or a project. It was an encounter, a living, transforming encounter with Jesus Christ, proclaimed with courage and embodied with love. The Gospel did not simply inform those people; it transformed them. It healed broken bodies. It freed wounded souls. It turned a city of strangers into something that looked, for a moment, like the Kingdom of God.

This is what the Gospel is meant to do here, in our parish, in our homes, in our neighborhoods. We live in our own version of Samaria: a world that sometimes feels fragmented, anxious, and far from God. And yet, we carry the same message Philip carried. We are sent to the same margins. We are entrusted with the same power, not our own power, but the power of the Risen Christ alive in us through Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist we share every week at this altar.

The question the First Reading leaves with us is a gentle but urgent one: Where is our Samaria? Who in our lives is waiting, perhaps without even knowing it, for someone to bring them the joy that only Christ can give? May this Easter season fill us with the courage of Philip and the joy of Samaria renewed.



Queridos amigos, al celebrar el Sexto Domingo de Pascua, en nuestra primera lectura, la Iglesia nos invita a dirigir nuestra mirada hacia una escena extraordinaria de los Hechos de los Apóstoles (Hechos 8:5-8, 14-17), una escena que habla no solamente a los primeros cristianos, sino también a cada uno de nosotros reunidos aquí hoy.

Felipe, uno de los primeros diáconos de la Iglesia, baja a Samaria, un lugar que el mundo judío de aquel tiempo ignoraba e incluso despreciaba. Él no espera a que la gente venga a él. Él va hacia ellos. Lleva la Buena Nueva a quienes estaban al margen, a quienes el mundo había rechazado. ¿Y qué sucede? Todo cambia. Las multitudes escuchan. Los enfermos son sanados. Los que estaban atados por la oscuridad son liberados. Y después viene el detalle más hermoso de todos: “Y había una gran alegría en aquella ciudad” (Hechos 8:8).

¿Qué fue lo que trajo esa alegría? No fue un programa ni un proyecto. Fue un encuentro, un encuentro vivo y transformador con Jesucristo, proclamado con valentía y vivido con amor. El Evangelio no solamente informó a aquellas personas; las transformó. Sanó cuerpos heridos. Liberó almas lastimadas. Convirtió una ciudad de extraños en algo que, por un momento, se parecía al Reino de Dios.

Esto es lo que el Evangelio está llamado a hacer aquí, en nuestra parroquia, en nuestros hogares y en nuestros vecindarios. Vivimos en nuestra propia versión de Samaria: un mundo que a veces se siente dividido, lleno de ansiedad y lejos de Dios. Y aun así, llevamos el mismo mensaje que llevó Felipe. Somos enviados a las mismas periferias. Se nos ha confiado el mismo poder, no nuestro propio poder, sino el poder de Cristo Resucitado vivo en nosotros por medio del Bautismo, la Confirmación y la Eucaristía que compartimos cada semana en este altar.

La pregunta que nos deja la Primera Lectura es suave, pero urgente: ¿Dónde está nuestra Samaria? ¿Quién en nuestras vidas está esperando, quizás sin siquiera saberlo, que alguien le lleve la alegría que solamente Cristo puede dar? Que este tiempo de Pascua nos llene con el valor de Felipe y con la alegría renovada de Samaria.

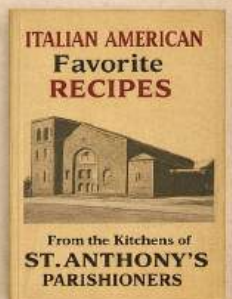
