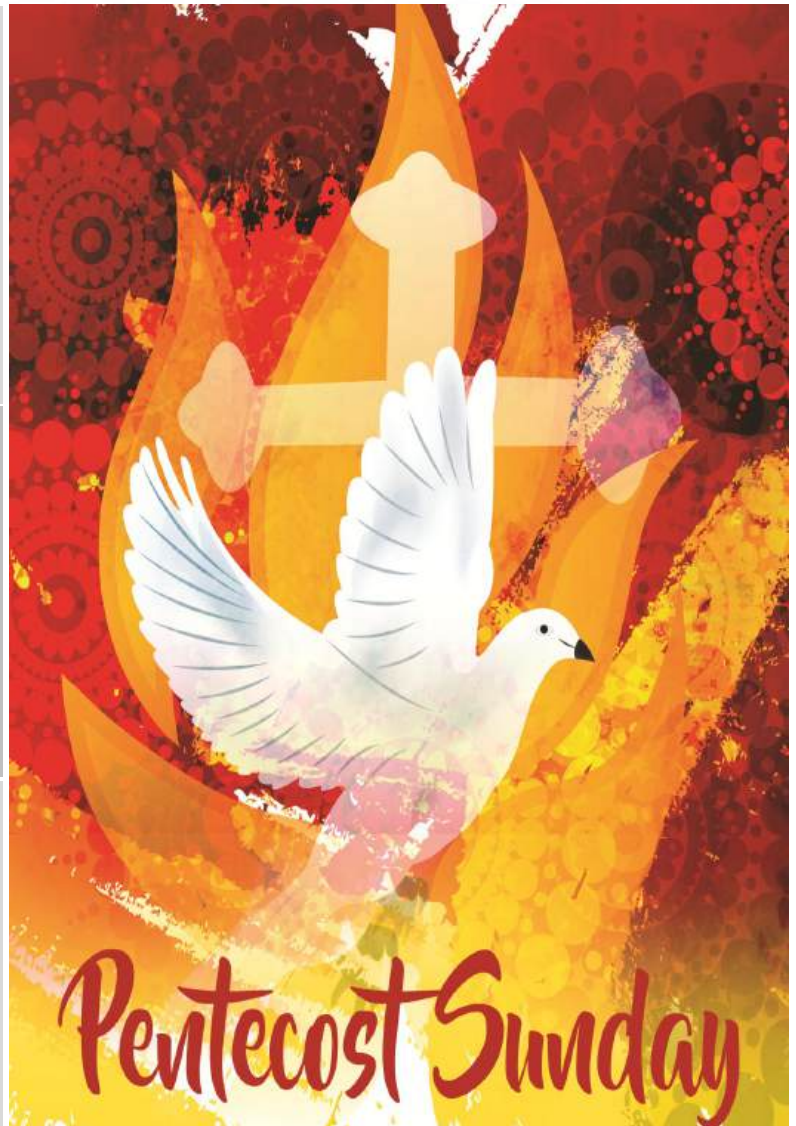

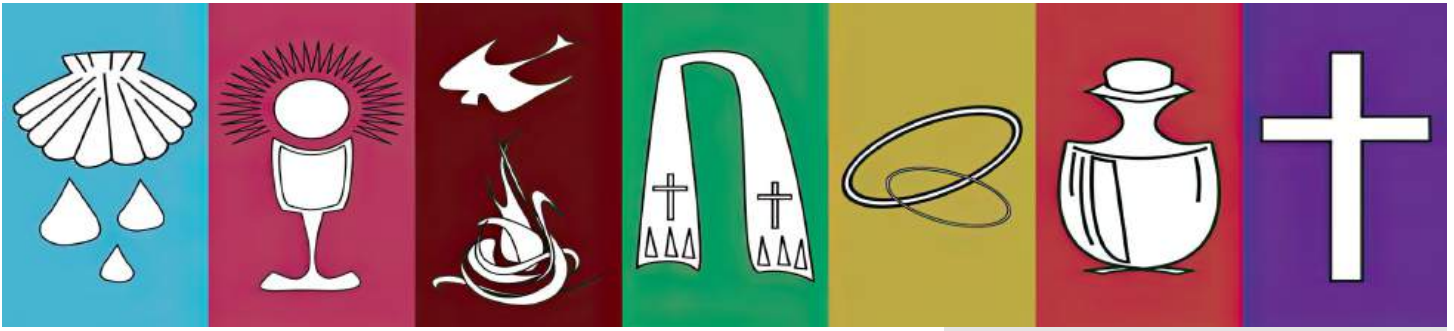

Dear Friends:

In a world filled with noise, anxiety, and constant activity, the Lord continues to invite us into His presence. One of the greatest gifts of our Catholic faith is Eucharistic Adoration, where we come before Jesus truly present in the Blessed Sacrament.

The Church teaches that Christ is present—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity—in the Holy Eucharist. In Adoration, we kneel before the Lord, not simply a symbol or memory. We come to worship Him, speak with Him, and rest in His love.

Many people wonder what they should do during Adoration. The answer is simple: be with Jesus. You may pray the Rosary, read Sacred Scripture, sit quietly in silence, or simply speak to Him from your heart. Even a few moments spent faithfully in His presence can bring peace, clarity, strength, and healing.

Eucharistic Adoration also deepens our love for the Mass. The more time we spend with Christ in Adoration, the more we hunger for Him in the Eucharist and carry His presence into our daily lives.

Here at St. Anthony's our Adoration chapel is open from 9:00am to 6:00pm Monday through Friday. I encourage every parishioner and family to make time regularly for Adoration. Bring your joys, burdens, questions, and hopes to the Lord. He waits for you patiently in the Blessed Sacrament.

May our parish become ever more centered on Jesus Christ, truly present among us in the Eucharist.
