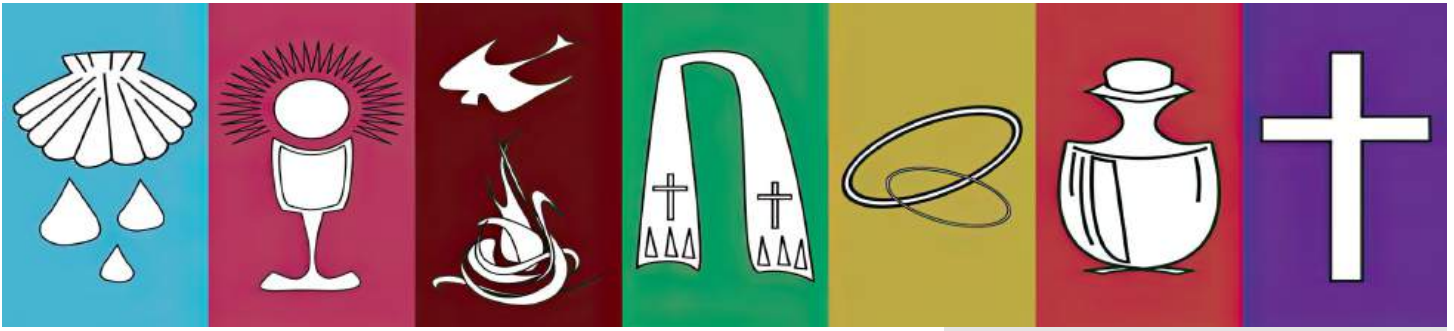

Together, this dynamic leadership team brings a wealth of educational expertise, a deep commitment to equity and diverse populations, and a shared passion for advancing the school's unique faith-filled mission.

A Leader for Vulnerable Learners

Joseph Nelson joins St. Anthony with over 20 years of comprehensive leadership experience in Iowa education, serving as a superintendent, elementary administrator, activities director, and district homeless liaison. For the past six years, Nelson has served as the superintendent for the Clarion-Goldfield-Dows School District, where he successfully oversaw 175 employees and a diverse student body of more than 1,000 students, characterized by high percentages of migrant and economically vulnerable learners.

Prior to his superintendency, Nelson spent a decade as an elementary administrator within the Southeast Polk Community School District, where his collaborative approach to school climate and academic rigor led his building to earn the prestigious National Blue Ribbon School award in 2012.

Nelson holds an Education Specialist degree with superintendent licensure and a Master of Science in educational leadership from Drake University, as well as a Bachelor of Science from the University of Northern Iowa.

A Former St. Anthony Teacher Returning Home

Joining Nelson is St. Anthony's new assistant principal, Taylor Reed. Taylor is a true product of Catholic education, attending Diocese of Des Moines Catholic Schools through 12th grade. Reed recently completed her administrator degree with financial assistance from the Diocese of Des Moines Catholic Schools Office scholarship program.

Reed spent her initial educator years as a second-grade teacher at St. Anthony, where she collaborated directly with teachers in the dual-language program to ensure equitable, high-quality instructional access across the student body.

Most recently, Reed has served as a third- and fourth-grade teacher at Sacred Heart Catholic School in West Des Moines. There, she actively represented her peers on the K-8 School Leadership Team, led Professional Learning Communities (PLCs), served on the Tier II MTSS and Tier I PBIS data teams, and planned more than 10 school-wide faith formation events annually as part of the Spiritual Life Team.

Reed recently completed her Master of Arts in educational policy and leadership studies, securing her administration degree from the University of Iowa. Now, she's coming full circle back to where her career began.

In the near future, an Open House will be held where the parishioners can meet Joe and Taylor. Again, we are pleased to welcome this dynamic team to our community.

Un líder al servicio de los estudiantes más vulnerables

Joseph Nelson llega a St. Anthony con más de 20 años de experiencia integral en liderazgo educativo en Iowa, desempeñándose como superintendente, administrador de escuela primaria, director de actividades y enlace distrital para estudiantes en situación de falta de vivienda. Durante los últimos seis años, Nelson ha servido como superintendente del Distrito Escolar Clarion-Goldfield-Dows, donde supervisó exitosamente a 175 empleados y a una comunidad estudiantil diversa de más de 1,000 alumnos, caracterizada por un alto porcentaje de estudiantes migrantes y de familias en situación económica vulnerable.

Antes de ser superintendente, Nelson trabajó durante una década como administrador de primaria en el Distrito Escolar Comunitario de Southeast Polk. Gracias a su enfoque colaborativo para fortalecer el ambiente escolar y la excelencia académica, su escuela recibió en 2012 el prestigioso reconocimiento National Blue Ribbon School.

Nelson cuenta con un título de Especialista en Educación con licencia de superintendente y una Maestría en Ciencias en Liderazgo Educativo por la Universidad Drake, además de una Licenciatura en Ciencias por la Universidad del Norte de Iowa.

Una exmaestra de St. Anthony regresa a casa

Acompañando a Nelson estará la nueva subdirectora de St. Anthony, Taylor Reed. Taylor es un verdadero fruto de la educación católica, ya que cursó toda su formación escolar en las escuelas católicas de la Diócesis de Des Moines hasta el grado 12. Recientemente, Reed completó su programa de formación administrativa gracias al apoyo económico otorgado por el programa de becas de la Oficina de Escuelas Católicas de la Diócesis de Des Moines.

Taylor inició su carrera docente como maestra de segundo grado en St. Anthony, donde colaboró directamente con los maestros del programa de educación bilingüe para garantizar un acceso equitativo y de alta calidad a la enseñanza para todos los estudiantes.

Más recientemente, Reed se desempeñó como maestra de tercer y cuarto grado en Sacred Heart Catholic School en West Des Moines. Allí representó activamente a sus compañeros en el Equipo de Liderazgo Escolar K-8, dirigió Comunidades Profesionales de Aprendizaje (PLC), formó parte de los equipos de datos MTSS Nivel II y PBIS Nivel I, y organizó más de 10 eventos anuales de formación en la fe para toda la escuela como integrante del Equipo de Vida Espiritual.

Reed obtuvo recientemente una Maestría en Artes en Estudios de Política y Liderazgo Educativo, obteniendo su título en administración educativa en la Universidad de Iowa. Ahora regresa al lugar donde comenzó su carrera profesional.

En un futuro cercano se llevará a cabo una Casa Abierta (Open House) para que los feligreses tengan la oportunidad de conocer a Joe y Taylor.

Nuevamente, nos complace dar la bienvenida a este dinámico equipo a nuestra comunidad.
